Video auditions:

We are accepting video auditions. We will accept audition applications until our workshop is full.

Dancers must submit the Online Audition Application (\$20 fee) and send video, head-shot, and at least one letter of recommendation to summer@bocaballet.org.

- The video should be no longer than three (3) minutes and include the following:
- Full-face video introduction, including your name and age.
- You should be the only one appearing on the video.

Any classical variation best suited for the dancer AND/OR a series of classroom exercises including adagio, petite allegro, and grande allegro.
