This 5-week intensive workshop includes Artistic Directors Paul Vasterling of Nashville Ballet; Douglas Martin of American Repertory Ballet; Victoria Morgan of Cincinnati Ballet and Adam Sklute of Ballet West. There will be classes in ballet technique, together with either jazz, character, modern or Pilates. Additional classes in pointe technique and variations will also be included. Dance enrichment sessions will include: question-and-answer sessions with professional dancers, technical theater production, video critique of historic ballet performances, plus discussions on resume, make-up and audition skills. In the Performance Intensive Workshop, you will learn what it is to be a member of a Corps de Ballet dancing with some of the finest professional dancers in the world. Placement will be made during the first week of classes.

The summer intensive workshop is offered: July 3RD - August 6TH, 2017, Monday through Saturday, 10am-6pm with a tuition of \$1,895 and room & board at \$2,995, and culminates with a full-stage production along with professional dancers.
