at Mizner Park Amphitheater**

Saturday, March 29, 2014 @ 7:30pm – Join Boca Ballet Theatre and the Symphonia of Boca Raton for a magical evening of music and dance at the Mizner Park Amphitheater. Presented by the City of Boca Raton, this will be the 20th year that Boca Ballet Theatre will perform in the park, and we are thrilled to continue the tradition. We are equally excited to collaborate with the orchestra, presenting the classic tale of *Peter and the Wolf* and the enchanting *Voyage Classique* at this wonderful family event.

Peter and the Wolf was composed by Sergei Prokofiev in 1936 as a musical symphony for a children's theatre company in Moscow. Prokofiev was commissioned to write this orchestrated children's story in order to cultivate the students' musical tastes at an early age.

Voyage Classique, influenced by 19th century classicism, is choreographed by BBT's Co-Artistic Director, Dan Guin. It is performed in classical tutus and features music excerpts from Leo Delibes' full-length ballet *La Source*.
